At Cape Cod Pediatrics, CCP, we believe in delivering the highest quality of healthcare. This includes recommending vaccinations as a part of preventative care for our patients. The recommended vaccine schedule is created by medical experts including the American Academy of Pediatrics.

Children need their vaccines on schedule so that they can benefit from all the protection the vaccines give. This schedule is designed to work best with a child's immune system at certain ages and with specific time intervals. There is no scientific data that spreading out vaccines is safer for a child.

At CCP, we do not accept families into our practice that choose not to vaccinate. We will be happy to discuss vaccinations and vaccine schedules with families that visit our practice. Once accepted, an agreed upon and written schedule for vaccines must be followed.
